Another Pentecost, and another, and another...

Make no mistake; you don't need to be converted to Christianity again. But every Christian needs to know both how we received this faith, and to what it calls us—and that might surprise you. Let's study Acts 10, discover how Peter finally got that and marvel at the changes in us when we do.

Acts 10:23b-48, page 75 in your Acts book

1. A result of God's _____

Vs. 29, "May I ask why you sent for me?"

2. A challenge to _____

Vs. 30, Cornelius replied, "From four days ago to this hour, I have been fasting. At the ninth hour, I was praying in my house when a man in shining clothes suddenly stood in front of me. He said, 'Cornelius, your prayer has been heard and your gifts to the poor have been remembered in God's sight. Therefore send to Joppa and call for Simon, who is called Peter.

3. The _____ work of the Holy Spirit

Vs. 44, While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who were listening to the message. the circumcised believers who had come with Peter were amazed that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out, even on the Gentiles. For they heard them speaking in other languages and praising God.

4. It comes through the _____ of the _____

Vs. 38, God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the Devil, because God was with him.

Vs. 39, Indeed, we are witnesses of all the things he did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem, yet they killed him by hanging him on a cross.

Vs. 40, But God raised him on the third day and caused him to be seen, not by all the people, but by the witnesses God had already chosen—by us, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.
